What are the UHRA and UHSD?

The UHRA: A nonprofit, nonpartisan, volunteer managed association organized to

- Promote the neighborhoods safe, quiet, family friendly ambiance
- Facilitate good relations with commercial interests
- Promote historic preservation and improve the esthetics of the neighborhood
- Promote neighborliness and support civic activities
- Be an instrument of political liaison
- Present the views and interest of its members to elected officials, city services, police, media, commercial and business entities, and with other neighborhood associations and community organizations

The UHRA Board is elected by members who reside or own property within the UH boundaries and is funded by an annual membership fee of \$25 per calendar year.

The UHSD: Authorized by La. R.S. 33:9091.6 for the purpose of promoting security and crime reduction. The UHSD is funded via a parcel fee collected by the City of NO Board of Liquidation on your property taxes. This fee is used to pay and manage police and private security to proactively patrol/respond to calls within the district.
