The Humana Rock 'n' Roll New Orleans Marathon & 1/2 Marathon will start on Poydras Street near Lafayette Square and finish in City Park near Tad Gormley Stadium. The Full & Half Marathon races will begin at 7:30 AM. The 10K will start earlier at 7 AM at St. Charles Street and Girod Street. The Saturday 5K will begin and end around Lafayette Square, with a tour of the French Quarter beginning at 8 AM.



A	Lafayette Sq	3 AM to 9 AM	Sections of North and South Maestri St will close at 8 AM Fri, February 8. Best in/out access during race: Park outside route & walk to your vehicle. LOCAL TRAFFIC & ST PATRICK'S CHURCH ONLY: Use eastbound Poydras St. to Loyola Ave, turn right on Loyola Ave and left on Girod Street BEFORE 7:30 AM. Continue on Girod St into downtown area for available parking.
B	B St. Charles St	6 AM to 10:45 AM	SOUTH OF CHARLES AVE & EAST OF LOUISIANA AVE: TO EXIT: Go east/downtown on Tchoupitoulas St to access Hwy 90. TO ENTER: Use Hwy 90 southbound, exit towards Tchoupitoulas St, turn right on Annunciation St. SOUTH OF CHARLES AVE & WEST OF LOUISIANA AVE: TO EXIT: Go uptown on Magazine St to Leake Ave and go lakebound on either Broadway St or Carrollton Ave. TO ENTER: Go riverbound on Broadway St, turn left on Leake Ave, and left on Magazine St. Alternately, exit I-10 at S Carrollton Ave and go riverbound, turn left on Leake Ave, and left on Magazine St.
C	Convention Center/ Cruise Terminal	6 AM to 11:15 AM	TO EXIT: Go east/downtown on Tchoupitoulas St to access Hwy 90. TO ENTER: Use Hwy 90 southbound, exit towards Tchoupitoulas St, turn right on Annunciation St.
	French Quarter	6 AM to 11:15 AM	ACCESS LANE: On Decatur St from St Philip St to Dumaine St to allow drivers to continue riverbound and turn right into French Quarter.
D	Lakeview Area	7:30 AM to 3:15 PM	Robert E Lee Blvd Westbound OPEN for vehicle traffic and Lakeview area access
	St. Pius X Church	7:30 AM to 3:30 PM	FROM THE WEST: Use Robert E. Lee Blvd eastbound to, continue to Spanish Fort Blvd. FROM THE EAST: Use St. Bernard Ave to enter I-610 W. Take Exit 1A for Canal Blvd, turn right on Canal Blvd. Turn right on Robert E Lee Blvd eastbound, continue to Spanish Fort Blvd.
E	Lakeshore Dr.	7:30 AM to 3 PM	Metered Access Lanes at St. Bernard & Robert E. Lee for westbound vehicle traffic or entrance to Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral.
